His hard work paved the road for thousands of patients to receive IVIG for disorders such as CIDP and myasthenia gravis. His generous donation of IVIG completed the study on stiff person syndrome at NIH. In 1997, Dr. Masood openly challenged the decision by Medicare to stop paying for IVIG in California for CIDP at great risk to his company. Despite the refusal to pay for IVIG, Dr. Masood continued providing the drug to patients until Medicare retroactively approved reimbursement. By establishing KabaFusion, Dr. Masood is returning to the infusion industry with the same principles, ethics and integrity.
